# POINT PARK REQUEST FORM & PARK REGULATIONS

MAYOR ADAMS DISTRIBUTED COPIES OF THE REQUEST FORM TO USE POINT PARK AND CHAPTER 96: PARK REGULATIONS. HE THINKS THE ORDINANCES NEED TO BE UPDATED, AS THEY WERE PASSED IN 1987 AND 1991. THE MAYOR HAS CONCERNS OF LETTING SOMEONE RENT POINT PARK FOR EXCLUSIVE USE. CITIZENS WOULDN'T BE ABLE TO HAVE ACCESS TO THE SPLASH PARK OR THE BOAT RAMP. HE ALSO STATED THAT WITH OUR CURRENT ORDINANCE, ALCOHOL IS NOT SUPPOSED TO BE ALLOWED AT POINT PARK OR ANY CITY OWNED PROPERTY ADJACENT TO THE PARK.
