**CALL TO ORDER:**

THE MEETING WAS THEN CALLED TO ORDER AT THE HOUR OF 7:00 P.M. BY MAYOR LOUDEN WHO OFFERED THE INVOCATION AND LED THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

**CODY DRODDY:** SAID HE LIVES AT 318 PORT WILLIAMS LANE. HE IS HERE TONIGHT TO EXPRESSED HIS CONCERNS ABOUT THE TRAFFIC AND SPEEDING CARS IN HIS NEIGHBORHOOD. MR. DRODDY HAS SPOKE WITH THE FORMER MAYOR ROBB ADAMS AND FORMER COUNCILWOMAN HAYLEY FRANKLIN ABOUT SPEED BUMPS BEING INSTALLED IN HIS NEIGHBORHOOD. MR. HE WANTS TO KNOW MORE ABOUT THE CITY ORDINANCES AND WHAT CAN BE DONE ABOUT THE SPEEDING CARS IN HIS NEIGHBORHOOD. MR. DRODDY IS WILLING TO FUND THE SPEED BUMP PROJECT.

CCCDC** – MATTHEW ADKINS, CCCDC DIRECTOR, SAID LAST FRIDAY STUDENTS FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY WERE HERE LOOKING AT CAMP KY SOC, MAINSTREET, AND THE 400 ACRES THAT THE UTILITY COMPANY OWNS AT GREENSBOTTOM, GENERAL BUTLER, AND POINT PARK. THE STUDENTS WILL DRAFT A FEW URBAN FORESTRY DESIGNS OF EACH LOCATION THAT CAN USE FOR FUTURE PLANNING. BEEN WORKING WITH CHIEF HOFMANN ON A GRANT FOR NEW THERMAL CAMERAS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. THE CCCDC YOUNG LEADERS PROGRAM HAS STARTED BACK. THE STUDENTS TOOK A FIELD TRIP TO A FARM IN WARSAW TO LEARN ABOUT DIFFERENT AGRICULTURAL METHODS. THEY RETURNED TO CARROLLTON AND WENT TO ANOTHER FARM, WHERE THEY CONTINUED THEIR AG EDUCATION AND LEARNED ABOUT CONVERSATION PRACTICES. THE NEXT TRIP WILL BE IN OCTOBER; THEY WILL TOUR NORTH AMERICAN STAINLESS AND LG & E/ KU. THEY WILL MAKE A TRIP IN NOVEMBER TO THE CITY, WHERE THEY WILL MEET WITH THE MAYOR TO LEARN ABOUT THE CITY GOVERNMENT.
